
UPCOMING HUBER PRODUCTIONS

MAINTENACE/UPGRADES

We've had a facelift! Thanks to the generous donations of local citizens, the Huber had the opportunity to upgrade the front façade of the building and the back wall of the stage. All of the large windows and all of the doors on front of building on High Street and on the first floor by the patio have been replaced with new, energy efficient doors and windows. The finish out work is being completed by Taylor Klepper with much attention to match the original woodworking installed during reconstruction. In addition, the brick on the back wall of the stage has been restored and sealed to protect it from further deterioration. The original brick is still exposed on the interior of the stage walls, which is the only remaining original brick that can be seen. The exterior walls were repaired or replaced earlier during the reconstruction phases in the past 25 years.


