



Set in 1905 in the little village of Anatevka, Russia, the story centers on Tevye, a poor milkman (Played by Peter Greer), and his five daughters Tzeitel (Kateri Mansel-Pleydell), Hodel (Madison Kindler), Chava (Lin Ballard), Shprintze (Anna Wiechart), and Bielke (Cataleya Perez). This colorful and tight-knit Jewish community consists of Golde, Tevye's wife (Rebecca Mansell-Pleydell), Yente the Matchmaker (Nichole Robinson), Motel the Tailor (Ben Harris), Perchik the Student (Alyx Harris), Fyedka (Jeremiah Hammon), Lazar Wolf the Butcher (Gary Coffelt), Mordcha the Innkeeper (Dusty Harris), The Rabbi (Bill Hobeck), Mendel, the Rabbi's Son (James Greer), Avram the Bookseller (Keith Robinson), Nachum the Begger (Clara Harris), Grandma Tzeitel (Earlee Harris), Fruma-Sarah (Mercedes Moncivais), Shaindel (Rochelle Riser), Yussel (David Vaughn), Villagers (Rosemary Cameron, Henry Clark, Avett Clem, Greyson Combs, Rachel Graber, Katherine Green, Jordan Hammersmith, Gemma Mansel-Pleydell, Layne Salisbury, Jordys Vance, Riana Yoder) and The Fiddler (Lydia Trzynka). Tevye tries to protect his daughters and instill them with traditional values in the face of changing social mores and the growing anti-Semitism of Czarist Russia. The Russians are an ever-present threat led by Constable (Dan Lehman), and his soldiers.

Rich in historical and ethnic detail, Fiddler on the Roof's universal theme of tradition cuts across barriers of race, class, nationality and religion. The show features iconic and beloved songs such as "Sunrise, Sunset," "If I Were a Rich Man," and "Matchmaker, Matchmaker," along with delightful choreography. Director Dave Snyder, is joined by Music Director Andy Gross,

Assistant Director Jordan Hammersmith, Choreographer Julie Hall and Producer Chris Feichter for this classic show at the Huber Opera House.

Winner of nine Tony Awards when it debuted in 1964, Fiddler on the Roof is the brainchild of Broadway legends, Jerome Robbins and Harold Prince; songwriters, Jerry Bock and Sheldon Harnick; and book writer, Joseph Stein. Touching audiences worldwide with its humor, warmth and honesty, this universal show is a staple of the musical theatre and is presented through special arrangements with Music Theater International (MTI). In the past year, the Huber has been the recipient of some larger donations from individuals, estates, and organizations. The Board of Directors review the maintenance and repairs list along with the "wish list" annually to prioritize the most immediate needs and projects to proceed with for that year. Recently these funds have been used to replace one of air conditioning units, update the lobby, and upgrade the stage lighting.
